In the Year 2000 . . .

By now, everyone has probably heard about the Year 2000 problem. Many computers manufactured before 1995 and the software they use, were programmed to recognize years solely by their last two digits for example "98" instead of 1998. The potential problem is come 2000, computers will read "00" as 1900, which could produce costly errors or crash systems altogether. Companies and governments are spending billions of dollars to prevent such problems by the end of this year.

United American's Data Processing (DP) staff has been addressing this problem since 1996 and has broken down overall efforts into four phases — two of which, the Identification and Analysis phases, are complete. Currently we are in the Testing phase, which should be wrapped up in March 1999. If necessary, time has also been reserved for a Clean-up phase through December 1999.

A team of Programmer/Analysts along with a Project Manager are dedicated to the Year 2000 compliance effort to insure project completion according to schedule.

Progress on the Year 2000 Project is being closely monitored. We'll keep you up-to-date in future issues of $U\!A$ News.
